Ice and Snow a Serious Danger on School Brae Letham

This letter is primarily to inform Fife Council of the conditions of School Brae, Letham, but also to deny you the opportunity to say, "We were not informed".

1. Ice and Snow combined with surface water emerging from a malfunctioning culvert under and around School Brae Letham is a serious danger to children and adults.
2. The council has not gritted School Brae, Letham.
3. The council maintains that School Brae, Letham, is not an Adopted Road, despite there being a primary school at the top of the hill: the very last building on the surfaced road.
4. Descending School Brae by car, at the time of writing this letter, is highly dangerous: other than not driving at all there is no safe speed that can safely negotiate the Brae downhill. It is impossible to attend to any emergency situation that may occur whilst descending the Brae.
5. At least one car has slid down School Brae **after** being parked on the iced-up road surface.
6. Children play in School Brae.
7. A number of elderly folk live in the upper levels of School Brae.
8. We maintain that Fife Council cannot so simply deny any responsibility for Health and Safety of this "un-Adopted Road", and that Fife Council should be, and are, responsible for the condition of School Brae, Letham.
