

## RULES

1. All jumping classes, including HC entries, will be judged under BSJA rules which may be modified at the sole discretion of the judge, whose decision **at all times** will be final.
2. No horse or pony will be allowed to jump in more than one height class (with the exception that eligible 12.2hh can enter class 7 - Open Pony).  
Lead Rein – rider 8 years or under. Entrants in these classes may only additionally enter Kindergarten classes.  
Kindergarten – rider 10 years or under. Entrants in these classes may only additionally enter either lead rein or novice classes. Adult helper allowed.  
Rider and horse/pony combinations entering novice classes may not enter open classes.  
Pony classes – these may be entered by horses under 14.2hh, with rider under the age of 16.  
Horse classes – These classes may be entered by horses 14.2hh and over with any age of rider and adults over 16 years riding ponies.
3. Novice riders and ponies or horses combinations may not have won 1st together in any jumping competition more than three times
4. Riders must be appropriately dressed when mounted, including a riding hat which meets British Riding Club standards. i.e. PAS 015:1998 or 2011, or VG1 01.040:2014-12, provided it is BSI kitemark or Inspec IC marked.
5. Competitors must have their own public liability insurance.
6. The organisers reserve the right to cancel, add to or amend any of the competitions as they see fit.
7. At the organisers' discretion, if there is sufficient interest then additional classes can be run or reinstated from previous schedules. Classes may be combined if there are less than 5 entries.
8. Bad language and undue use of the stick will not be tolerated in or out of the ring and may, at the organisers' discretion, lead to elimination.

**RING ONE, COMMENCING 10.00AM PROMPT**

**SHOW JUMPING**

(all classes £10)

- Class 1 **Lead Rein Jumping**  
Maximum jump height 30cm.
- Class 2 **Kindergarten Jumping** (adult helper allowed in ring)  
Maximum jump height 30cm.
- Class 3 **12.2hh Novice Jumping**  
Maximum first round height 50cm.
- Class 4 **12.2hh Intermediate Jumping**  
Maximum first round height 60cm
- Class 5 **Novice Pony Jumping (Under 14.2hh)**  
Maximum first round height 50cm.
- Class 6 **Intermediate Pony Jumping (Under 14.2hh)**  
Maximum first round height 60cm.
- Class 7 **Open Pony Jumping (Under 14.2hh)** Additional Trophy awarded to the highest placed pony not exceeding 12.2hh.  
Maximum first round height 70cm.

**NOT BEFORE 2PM**

- Class 8 **Novice Horse Jumping (14.2hh & over)**  
Maximum first round height 60cm
- Class 9 **Intermediate Horse Jumping (14.2hh & over)**  
Maximum first round height 75cm
- Class 10 **Horse Scurry (14.2hh and over)**  
Maximum height 70cm – one round of jumps against the clock, least faults and fastest time wins
- Class 11 **Open Horse Jumping – 85cm (14.2hh and over)**  
Maximum first round height 85cm
- Class 12 **Open Horse Jumping 95cm (14.2hh & over)**  
Maximum first round height 95cm

**Clear Round Jumping £5, entry on the field.**

**RING TWO, COMMENCING 9.30AM**

**TURNOUT AND SHOWING.**

- Class 13 **Turnout for ponies** (under 14.2hh, riders 16 years or under). (£5)  
**On field ready for judging at 9.30am prompt - no late entries will be accepted.**
- Class 14 **Pony Club Pony** (under 14.2hh, riders 16 years or under). Walk, trot and canter show and optional jump. Membership of a pony club not required (£10)
- Class 15 **Turnout for Horses** 14.2hh and over (£5)  
**On field ready for judging at 1.00pm prompt - no late entries will be accepted.**
- Class 16 **Riding Club Horse** Walk, trot and canter show and optional jump. Membership of a riding club not required. (£10)

**RING THREE, HANDY PONY**

**From 10.30am to 3.00pm: Handy Horse or Pony**, for any size of horse or pony and any age of rider. Maximum of two attempts per horse/rider combination. Enter at ring (£5)

**RING FOUR, COMMENCING 11.00 AM** (£10 for 4 games)

- Class 17 **Lead Rein Games** 4 Games
- Class 18 **12.2hh Games** 4 Games
- Class 19 **13.2hh Games** 4 Games
- Class 20 **14.2hh and over Games** 4 Games

**POINTS COMPETITIONS**

**THE SNOOPY CHALLENGE CUP for most adaptable horse or pony**

**DORAN TROPHY for best veteran (over 20 years old)**

Trophies to be awarded to the horse or pony gaining most points during the course of the day for entry into:

- Any Jumping Class (best result counts)
- Games
- Handy Horse or Pony
- Turnout
- Riding Club Horse or Pony Club Pony

Points awarded - 2 points for entering, and 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 for 1<sup>st</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> place respectively. Entry free and automatic for every entrant to the show.
