

RULES

1. All jumping classes, including HC entries, will be judged under BSJA rules which may be modified at the sole discretion of the judge, whose decision **at all times** will be final.
2. Pony classes – may be entered by ponies under 14.2hh, with rider under the age of 16.
Horse classes – may be entered by horses 14.2hh and over with any age of rider and adults (16 years and over) riding ponies.
3. Showing classes & Handy Pony can be on lead rein (8yrs or under).
4. Competitors may enter a **maximum of 2 sequential jumping classes**.
5. The first part of the jumping course will be untimed. Riders will then immediately jump a second section of the course which will be a timed as a “jump-off” for final placings. (Class 3 Lead rein riders will stop for a few seconds after the first section - so their handler gets their breath back!)
6. It is the responsibility of the rider (or their Guardian) to ensure that they are appropriately dressed when mounted, including a riding hat which meets British Riding Club standards. i.e. PAS 015:1998 or 2011, or VG1 01.040:2014-12, provided it is BSI kitemark or Inspec IC marked.
7. Competitors must have their own public liability insurance.
8. The organisers reserve the right to cancel, add to or amend any of the competitions as they see fit.
9. At the organisers’ discretion, if there is sufficient interest then additional classes can be run or reinstated from previous schedules. Classes may be combined if there are less than 5 entries.
10. Bad language and undue use of the stick will not be tolerated in or out of the ring and may, at the organisers’ discretion, lead to elimination.
11. All COVID restrictions, social distancing and other guidelines in place on 22nd August 2021 must be followed while on the show ground. Anyone not complying with a reasonable request made by the organisers may be asked to leave the show ground.
12. All entries must be made in advance (See entry form for details). Entries may need to be closed if class limits are reached. **NO ENTRIES ON THE FIELD.**

RING THREE, FROM 9.30AM - PONY TURNOUT AND SHOWING

- Class 1 **Turnout for ponies** (under 14.2hh, riders under 16 yrs)
- Class 2 **Pony Club Pony** (under 14.2hh, riders under 16 yrs). Walk, trot and canter show and optional jump. (*canter optional for lead-rein riders*). Membership of a pony club not required.

RING ONE, FROM 11.00AM

PONY SHOW JUMPING (under 14.2hh)

- Class 3 **Lead Rein Jumping (under 14.2hh)**
Maximum jump height 30cm.
Riders 8yrs or under.
- Class 4 **Kindergarten Pony Jumping (under 14.2hh)**
Maximum jump height 30cm. Riders 10yrs or under can have assistance in the ring
- Class 5 **Beginners Pony Jumping (under 14.2hh)**
Maximum jump height 30cm.
- Class 6 **Novice Pony Jumping**
Maximum first round height 50cm
- Class 7 **Intermediate Pony Jumping**
Maximum first round height 60cm

RING TWO, 11.0AM to 3.00PM

Class 8 Handy Pony /Horse Obedience Test

A COVID friendly Handy Pony/Obedience test with non-contact obstacles to show how well you can control your horse/pony round and through different spaces.
For any size of horse/pony and any age of rider.
Go to Ring 2, between 11 and 3pm, to do your test at a time that suits you between your other classes

RING THREE, FROM 12NOON - HORSE TURNOUT AND SHOWING

- Class 9 **Turnout for Horses** (14.2hh and over)
- Class 10 **Riding Club Horse** (14.2hh and over) Walk, trot and canter show and optional jump. Membership of a riding club not required.

RING ONE, FROM 1.30PM

HORSE SHOW JUMPING (14.2hh and over)

- Class 11 **Beginners Horse Jumping (14.2hh & over)**
Maximum first round height 45cm
- Class 12 **Novice Horse Jumping (14.2hh & over)**
Maximum first round height 65cm
- Class 13 **Intermediate Horse Jumping (14.2hh & over)**
Maximum first round height 75cm

POINTS COMPETITIONS

THE SNOOPY CHALLENGE CUP for most adaptable horse or pony

DORAN TROPHY for best veteran (over 20 years old)

Trophies to be awarded to the horse or pony gaining most points during the course of the day for entry into:

- Any Jumping Class (best result counts)
- Handy Pony/Horse Obedience
- Turnout
- Riding Club Horse or Pony Club Pony

Points awarded - 2 points for entering, and 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 for 1st to 5th place respectively. Entry free and automatic for every entrant to the show.
